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

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


Quality Circle Time (QCT) is a popular activity that's used in many primary schools to help develop positive relationships between children. It aims to give them tools to engage with and listen to each other.

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
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Pictionary - Revising Adjectives through Pictionary

Like dark is nothing but absence of light, shadow is just a darker surface area. The reason why flame does not make shadow is because it itself is the source of light

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


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
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

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
A festival shows new beginning and so our students used these kites to express what's in them and start something new in their life....
